## When We Return After Easter

\* If your child displays any of the symptoms of Covid, **please do not send your child into school.**

Organise for a test immediately.

\* If a member of your household feels unwell and starts to display symptoms **please do not send your child into school.**

Keep him/her at home and arrange for a test.

\* If your child feels unwell, they don't feel right or they just don't feel 100%, **please do not send your child into school.**

Wait until they feel better and/or arrange a test

\* If your child comes into contact with someone who later tests positive, **please do not send your child into school.**

Arrange for a test and self-isolate for 10 clear days.

**Symptoms of Covid : (list including new variants)**

A new and continuous cough

High temperature

Change in smell and or taste

Sore throat

Fatigue

Muscle aches

Headache

On our return, we want to keep everyone safe so please play safe and be cautious. Thanks.

## Essentials On Return

Please could everyone try to ensure that when their child returns to school, they have their own pack of **tissues** and mini bottle of **sanitising hand gel**. This will help reduce any virus spread. It would be appreciated.

## Covid Positive Test

If your child shows symptoms over first few days of the holiday period, **please arrange a test immediately.** If the PCR test shows positive, it is important that you **contact me as a matter of urgency.**

I can then inform all those parents of the children, who your child may have been in close contact with during the last week prior to the Easter break.

Those parents would then need to follow the self-isolation guidance.
