Modelling the Digestive System



The Digestive starts in the mouth. We put bananas and vegetables in a bowl and crushed it with a fork. The fork did the job of our teeth, grinding and crushing the food. Next we added water, this was the saliva it helps to swallow better. It then

makes it way down into the oesophagus which was a piping bag. We had to squeeze it to the bottom of the piping bag, we chopped the end off and then it was ready. After that it goes down into the stomach which was a sealable freezer bag the bag had some green food colouring in and it was the food acid. We used yellow food colouring for the bile from the liver. Following that we put the juices into some tights which were the intestine, the water was coming out of the



tights to make it solid. Then we chopped the end of the tights and squeeze it into the toilet which was a plate. Finally it came out as firm solid faeces.
