

# Neil Armstrong: Biography

Neil Armstrong was the first man to set foot on the moon. Neil Armstrong was born on the 5 of August 1930 in Ohio. His dad was an auditor for the Ohio state government, he had had a younger brother and a younger sister.



At an early age, his dad took him on an aeroplane ride which inspired him to join the naval air station.

He fought in the Korean War. After he fought in the Korean War, he retired from the army and joined the NASA corps in 1962.

Many years later, after all of his training, he got to be the first man on the moon. On the 16 July 1969 he landed on the moon in the Apollo 11 shuttle and he walked around the moon for about 2 hours. He landed in the Atlantic Ocean.

He sadly died on the 25 august 2012 in the Ohio hospital, he died of difficulty with cardiac surgery. He will be remembered for many years for his bravery.
